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PAVEMENT MAINTENANCE: SLURRY SEALING

Dear Resident:

The Town has contracted Graham Contractors, Inc. to perform a slurry sealing project. Slurry sealing is an aggregate and emulsion coating applied to roads in good condition to prolong their life. This type of pavement maintenance is a proven method of critical asset protection.

The contractor is tentatively scheduled to perform the slurry seal on October 2, 2018. You are receiving this letter because you either live on a street that is proposed for sealing, or you will be affected by the road closure of a street in proximity to you. A list of slurry streets is provided on the back page.

Roads that are being sealed will be closed for **one work day**. The closure allows the contractor to perform preparation, sealing, and curing. The street, street parking and driveways will not be available or accessible during the day of sealing. Access to your street will be available by 6:00 PM. Overnight parking on nearby streets will be available for effected residents the night before the closure.

Well in advance of October 2nd, please:

- **Turn off sprinklers and pumps** to protect the road surface from water during the curing
- **Inform/reschedule deliveries and visitors.**
- **Do not drive your car on the fresh slurry.** A cool surface and the absence of workers is not an indication that the road is ready for traffic: It still needs to cure.
- To avoid spreading oil and to keep the jobsite safe for the workers, **do not walk, bike, or allow your pets on the slurry** until it is clearly reopened to the public at the end of the day. Some roads do not have sidewalks, so please plan ahead.
