



Notice of Construction & Parking Restrictions

TOWN OF ANSELMO | 2019 PAVEMENT REHAB

San Francisco Blvd & Adjacent Streets: 04/22/19 to 05/24/19

Pavement rehabilitation work will take place from Monday, April 22, 2019 to Friday, May 24, 2019. Unless otherwise notified, work will occur between M-Fri; 8:00 AM to 5:00PM.

We always try our best to minimize inconvenience to the community while we are making improvements, However, please be aware of the following impacts INCLUDING FULL ROAD CLOSURES:

- **Roadways scheduled for repairs:**
 - ALL San Francisco Blvd
 - Alderney Rd (from Memorial Park to north-east of El Cerrito Ave)

Traffic Impacts

- **Moderate Delays due to road work:**

We will use detours, flagging, and/or lane closures on a daily basis to maintain local access for residents/businesses whenever possible.

Emergency vehicle access will be maintained at all times. During all operations, please expect delays and allow extra time in your planning. When traffic impacts are significant, please reduce using the road as much as practical so that progress can be optimized, and the project can be completed sooner. Your driveway may also be blocked during various phases of work. However, if your driveway will be blocked for more than 15 minutes or will be closed for the work day, you will receive written notification 72 hours in advance.

- **Uneven surfacing to follow within the next four to five weeks.**

While we are working, the roads may have uneven surfacing. Please use caution while driving.
- **ROAD CLOSURES & Restricted parking within San Francisco Blvd & Adjacent Streets:**

During specific operations, it will be necessary to close entire blocks of San Francisco Blvd to safely and efficiently complete the work. Again, impacted properties will receive written notice 72 hours in advance. "NO PARKING. TOW AWAY" signs will be posted prior to the beginning of work in the areas where parking must be prohibited. Any vehicle parked in a "No Parking" zone will be towed at the owners' expense.

Please make arrangements to park your vehicles on an adjacent street where street parking is not restricted during this time. For parking overnight on another street 1) be sure to park such that large trucks and fire engines can get around your car easily and 2) you will not be ticketed for overnight parking. When work has been completed in each area, the parking prohibition will end and all signs will be removed.
