Dear Valued Customer:

In January, Pacific Gas and Electric Company (PG&E) wrote to you about upgrading a portion of our natural gas distribution system near Sir Francis Drake Boulevard and Center Boulevard in San Anselmo. This project will improve the safety and integrity of the pipelines that deliver natural gas directly to homes and businesses.

We are now writing with a project location update. In addition to the work already in progress on Sir Francis Drake Boulevard and Center Boulevard, we will be working on Sir Francis Drake Boulevard between Red Hill Avenue and Bridge Avenue beginning Monday, March 16. Work is expected to last until mid-April, although weather and other factors affecting safe working conditions could change the schedule. To minimize traffic impacts and due to the lack of a suitable detour, crews will work at the new location in the evening and early morning hours between 8 p.m. and 6 a.m. PG&E will clearly mark all work areas, and traffic flaggers will help to direct traffic. Please plan for minor delays when driving through this area.

At times, you may smell gas and hear a loud hissing noise as we vent natural gas from the pipeline using safe and common techniques. Although this is normal when crews are working, we encourage anyone who has concerns about the smell of gas to call us 24 hours a day at **1-800-743-5000**.

Please remember as you are working in your yard, no project is too small to call 811. One free and easy call to 811 at least two business days before digging gets your underground utilities marked so you can dig safely.
