

RESOLUTION NO. 3633

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO AUTHORIZING THE TOWN ADMINISTRATOR TO PREPARE AND SIGN A NOTICE OF INTENT TO COMPLY WITH A GENERAL PERMIT FOR STORM WATER DISCHARGES FROM SMALL MUNICIPAL SEPARATE STORM SEWER SYSTEMS

Whereas, the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency, under amendments to the 1987 Federal Clean Water Act, imposed regulations that mandate local governments reduce to the maximum extent practicable pollutants in storm water discharged from municipal storm drain conveyance systems; and

Whereas, under authority of the California Porter-Cologne Water Quality Control Act, the State Water Resources Control Board and its Regional Boards have been delegated the authority to adopt NPDES permits and waste discharge requirements for municipal stormwater discharges; and

Whereas, all municipalities in Marin County and Marin County Flood Control and Water Conservation District have been required by the Federal Government and the San Francisco Bay Regional Water Quality Control Board to apply for a General Permit for Storm Water Discharges from Small Municipal Separate Storm Sewer systems ("General Permit"); and

Whereas, the thirteen (13) governmental entities have approved the Marin Street Light Acquisition Joint Powers Authority [MSLAJPA] to fund activities to be performed jointly; and

Whereas, on November 26, 2002 an agreement delineating activities to be implemented by all participating agencies entitled [Agreement with the Marin Streetlight Acquisition Joint Powers Authority] was approved collectively by all participating agencies, with the Marin County Flood Control and Water Conservation District authorized to coordinate and manage the program within the District as the Marin County Stormwater Pollution Prevention Program (MCSTOPPP)

Whereas, MCSTOPPP has previously prepared a Storm Water Management Plan titled Action Plan 2005, and that is the plan intended to use for coverage under the general permit.

Now, Therefore Be It Resolved that the Town of San Anselmo hereby:

1. Certifies that the provisions of the General Permit, including the Storm Water Management Plan, will be complied with.
2. Authorizes the Town Administrator to prepare and sign the Notice of Intent and to take any other necessary actions to apply for coverage, as a co-permittee with the

RESOLUTION NO. 3077

A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO,
COUNTY OF MARIN, STATE OF CALIFORNIA,
REGARDING THE REVISED COUNTY HAZARDOUS WASTE MANAGEMENT PLAN

WHEREAS, the California Health and Safety Code authorizes counties to prepare and adopt hazardous waste management plans, and requires cities to adopt provisions of the county hazardous waste management plan into city general plans and/or ordinances; and

WHEREAS, the County of Marin prepared a Draft Hazardous Waste Management Plan in March 1988 and revised it in December 1988 in response to comments received by Marin's cities and town, local industry and environmental groups, the public-at-large, the County Advisory Committee for the Plan, County Board of Supervisors, and the California Department of Health Services; and

WHEREAS, safe and responsible management of hazardous wastes is critical to the protection of public health and the environment; and

WHEREAS, the Revised County Hazardous Waste Management Plan provides guidance for waste minimization, increased recycling, improved waste management, safe transportation, capable emergency response, and an effective siting and permitting process for potential hazardous waste management facilities in the county; and

WHEREAS, the city participated in preparation of the Draft Plan and has reviewed the Revised Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT the Town Council of the Town of San Anselmo approves the Revised County Hazardous waste Management Plan of December 30, 1988 and recommends that the Marin County Board of Supervisors adopt the County Hazardous Waste Management Plan as the Final County Hazardous Waste Management Plan and submit it to the California Department of Health Services for approval in accordance with State Assembly Bill 2948 (Tanner 1986) and subsequent legislation.
