WHEREAS, the Town of San Anselmo recognizes that disasters do not recognize city, county, or special district boundaries; and

WHEREAS, the Town of San Anselmo seeks to maintain and enhance both a disaster-resistant Town and region by reducing the potential loss of life, property damage, and environmental degradation from natural disasters, while accelerating economic recovery from those disasters; and

WHEREAS, the Town of San Anselmo is committed to increasing the disaster resistance of the infrastructure, health, housing, economy, government services, education, environment, and land use systems in the Town as well as in the Bay Area as a whole; and

WHEREAS, the federal Disaster Mitigation Act of 2000 (Act) requires all cities, counties, and special districts to adopt a Local Hazard Mitigation Plan to receive disaster mitigation funding from FEMA; and

WHEREAS, the Association of Bay Area Governments (ABAG) has approved and adopted the ABAG report *Taming Natural Disasters*, created in collaboration with the participating jurisdictions, as the multi-jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan for the San Francisco Bay Area;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town of San Anselmo adopts, and adapts with its local annex, this multi-jurisdictional plan as its Local Hazard Mitigation Plan.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Town of San Anselmo commits to continuing to take those actions and initiating further actions, as appropriate, as identified in the Town of San Anselmo Annex of that multi-jurisdictional Local Hazard Mitigation Plan and by adopting this list of mitigation strategies as the Implementation Appendix of the Conservation Element of Its General Plan.




