

Ordinance #17

Providing for the Protection of Trees.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows.

It is hereby made unlawful and a misdemeanor for any person or persons to cut, girdle, trim or in any manner injure any tree growing upon the public streets of the Town of San Anselmo; and it is made a misdemeanor for any person to lurch or tie any horse or other animal to any growing tree on said streets. Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not to exceed Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or by imprisonment in the County Jail not to exceed ten days.

This Ordinance to take effect immediately.

Passed and approved this 25th day of July 1907 by the following vote.

Any person violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be punishable by a fine of not to exceed Ten Dollars (\$10.00) or by imprisonment in the County Jail not to exceed ten days.
