

Ordinance # 18 ^{superseded} by Ord. # 17

"Regulating the Speed of Motor Vehicles and Bicycles"

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:--

Section 1. No person or persons shall, within the corporate limits of the Town of San Anselmo, operate or cause to be operated any mobile, automobile, locomobile, motor bicycle or any other machine or apparatus using electricity, gasoline or other product of petroleum, or other motive power, at a greater rate of speed than ten miles an hour or pass over crossings at street intersections at a greater rate of speed than six miles an hour or across bridges at a greater rate than four miles an hour.

Section 2. Every person operating or having control of any mobile, automobile, locomobile, or vehicle or machine of similar character shall on approaching any street crossing give some danger signal as a warning to pedestrians.

Section 3. It shall be unlawful for any person or persons to ride or drive any bicycle, bicycle tandem or other vehicle or machine of similar character, upon or along any public street at a rate of speed greater than ten miles an hour.

Section 4. Every person riding or driving any vehicle as described in Section 1 and Section 3 of this article upon or along any public street shall keep to the right of the center of the roadway on approaching or passing other vehicles.

Section 5. Any person or persons who shall violate any of the provisions of this article shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof

Ordinance #18 continued shall be punished by a fine not exceeding One Hundred Dollars, or by imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

This Ordinance shall take effect immediately.
