

Ordinance # 20

Relating to the Licensing of
Peddlers, Solicitors and other Agents.

The Board of Trustees of the Town
of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:—

Section 1 Every person, firm, association or
corporation who peddles, or from place
to place, within the Town of San Anselmo
offers for sale, or does sell, barter or
exchange anything, or any goods, wares
or merchandise that in his possession
must procure from the Town Marshall
a license therefor, and pay for such
license the sum of Five Dollars per
quarter year: provided however, that
nothing in this Section contained shall
require those who sell, barter or exchange
to traders or merchants for re-sale to
procure a license therefor. Provided that
each peddler shall have securely fastened
or attached to his vehicle, basket or pack,
a metallic plate or tag which shall
specify the quarter for which said
license shall have been issued.

Section 2 Every person, firm, association or
corporation who shall solicit or take
orders within said Town for the exchange,
sale, barter or delivery of any goods,
wares or merchandise, not then in his
actual possession as a peddler must
procure a license therefor from the Town
Marshall, and pay for such license the
sum of Twenty Five Dollars per quarter
year: provided however, that this section
shall not apply to salesmen or agents
for wholesale houses or firms who solicit
orders from and sell for re-sale to retail
dealers, or to manufacturers for
manufacturing purposes.

Section 3 Every person who, not having

Ordinance #20 continued within said Town a fixed place of business, regularly kept open, with some one in charge thereof for the transaction of the particular business engaged during the hours customary for the transaction of such business, travels from place to place and offers to or does sell, barter or exchange anything then in his possession in said Town, (excepting the persons in this Ordinance excepted) shall be deemed a peddler within the meaning of this Ordinance. But this section shall not apply to persons offering for sale fruit, vegetables or other produce raised by themselves.

Section 4 Every person who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding fifty dollars or by imprisonment for a period not exceeding thirty days or by both such fine and imprisonment. This Ordinance shall take effect from and after the date of its passage.
