

Ordinance # 25

"Amending Ordinance # 11 providing for the sale of intoxicating liquors by adding a new section thereto to be numbered 2 1/2."

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:—

Section 1 Ordinance # 11 of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo is hereby amended to read as follows:— Section 2 1/2. Any person carrying on in good faith a regularly equipped hotel may sell and dispose of intoxicating liquors at meals served in the regular dining room of said hotel after having first obtained the license in this Ordinance provided. And no liquor shall be served or disposed of at meals other than at those meals served between the hours of 6 A.M. and 8 A.M., 12 M. and 2 P.M. and 5 P.M. and 8 P.M. of each day.

Section 2 This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force from and after the date of its passage.
