

Ordinance # 27

"Providing for the giving of notices of elections"

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

ction 1. All elections in the Town of San Anselmo shall be held in accordance with the general election laws of the State of California so far as the same are applicable.

ction 2. The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo shall give notice of elections held in said town by causing notices to be posted by the clerk of the Town of San Anselmo in a least five public places in said town for at least 10 consecutive days before the date of every election to be held in said Town.

Said notices shall contain a statement of the time of election, the office to be filled thereat, the names of the election officers, the propositions to be voted upon thereat, the polling place or places and the hours of opening and closing of polls.

ction 3. This ordinance shall be in force from and after the date of its passage.
