

- Ordinance #35 -

"Amending Ordinance #11, Providing for the Sale of Intoxicating Liquors, by amending Section #2 1/2, and by adding thereto a new section to be numbered 2-3/4 of said Ordinance."

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do Ordain as follows: -

1. Ordinance No. 11 of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo is hereby amended to read as follows:

2-1/2. Any person, firm or corporation, carrying on in good faith a regularly equipped hotel, restaurant, or boarding-house, may sell and dispense intoxicating liquors at meals served in the regular dining-room of said hotel, restaurant, or boarding-house, after having first obtained the license of this Ordinance provided, and no liquor shall be served or dispensed at meals other than at those meals served between the hours of 6 A.M. and 8 A.M. and 12 M. and 2 P.M. and 5 P.M. and 8 P.M. of each day.

2. Ordinance No. 11 of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo is hereby amended by adding thereto a new Section to be numbered 2-3/4:

2-3/4. Any and all persons, firms or corporations, carrying on the business referred to in Section 2-1/2 of said Ordinance No. 11, shall at the hour of 11 o'clock P.M. of every day remove any and all customers and patrons therefrom, and close and securely lock the doors of their dining-room, or rooms, in any and all places therein wherein meals or intoxicating liquors are dispensed, given away, or sold, and shall keep the same securely locked and closed and exclude all customers and patrons therefrom, until the hour of 6 o'clock A.M. of the next succeeding day.

3. This Ordinance shall take effect from
