

ORDINANCE NO. 60 - *Amended by No. 76*

AMENDING SECTIONS 6 AND 7 OF ORDINANCE NO. 44,  
PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS,  
AND REGULATING THE TRAFFIC THEREOF.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do  
ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 6 of Ordinance No. 44 of the Board of  
Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo is hereby amended to read  
as follows:

(Section 6) The rate of license in this Ordinance shall  
be as follows: for every person to whom a permit is granted to  
sell liquor under the provisions of this Ordinance, the sum of  
One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) per annum, payable in advance, in  
lawful money of the United States, at the office of the Tax Col-  
lector of the Town of San Anselmo, to said Tax Collector.

Section 2. Section 7 of Ordinance No. 44 of the Board of  
Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo is hereby amended to read  
as follows:

(Section 7) The license herein required must be procured  
from the Tax Collector immediately before the commencement of  
the business herein required to be licensed, and shall be issued  
for the calendar year in which said license is granted, and  
separate permission and license must be obtained for each branch  
establishment or separate place of business.

Section 3. Said license shall be due and payable on the first  
day of January of each year, in advance, except that the Town  
Marshall shall, after the passage of this Ordinance, collect from  
all persons, firms and corporations, upon the expiration of the  
present issued licenses, a pro-rata of the annual license tax,  
up to and including the 31st day of December, 1900 and that  
thereafter, on the first day of January of each succeeding  
year, he shall collect the annual tax herein provided to be paid.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its passage.
