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PROVIDING FOR TOILETS FOR GROUNDS USED OR RENTED FOR CAMPING PURPOSES.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It is and shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation or association, either as owner, lessee, or occupant, of any lands within Sewer District No. 2, in the Town of San Anselmo, to use, occupy, rent, lease, or allow, or permit to be used, any lands within said Sewer District No. 2, for camping purposes, without first providing thereon, for use by the campers, a suitable patent toilet or toilets properly connected with the sewer system now established in said District; and provided further, that a separate toilet shall be installed for every camp upon said lands that is located ^{over} One hundred and fifty (150) feet distant from a toilet established thereon.

Section 2. It is and shall be unlawful for any person, firm, corporation or association, either as owner, lessee or occupant, of any lands within Sewer District No. 1, in the Town of San Anselmo, to use, occupy, rent, lease, or allow, or permit to be used, any lands within said Sewer District No. 1, for camping purposes, without first providing thereon, for use by the campers, a proper or suitable cess-pool; and provided further that a cess-pool shall be installed for every camp that is located ^{over} One hundred and fifty (150) feet distant from a cess-pool established thereon.

Section 3. The term "camp", as used herein, means the ground or spot upon which each collection of tents, huts, etc., are erected for the shelter or convenience of each individual party of friends or acquaintances.

Section 4. Any person, firm, corporation or association who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Three hundred Dollars (\$300.00), or by imprisonment for not more than Three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.
