DEFINING WHAT IS A NUISANCE AND EMPOWERING  
THE BOARD OF HEALTH TO ABATE AND SUMMARILY  
DESTROY SAID NUISANCE.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Any article of food or drink in the possession, or under the control, of any person, firm, association or corporation, which is tainted, decayed, spoiled, or otherwise unwholesome, or unfit to be eaten or drunk, is hereby declared to be, and is, a public nuisance.

Section 2. The Board of Health of the Town of San Anselmo is hereby authorized and directed to abate said nuisance, and to seize, confiscate, condemn and destroy any article of food or drink in the possession, or under the control, of any person, firm, association or corporation, which has become tainted, decayed, spoiled, or otherwise unwholesome, or unfit to be eaten or drunk.

Section 3. The term "food", as used herein, includes all articles used for food or drink by man, whether simple, mixed or compound.

Section 4. Any person, firm, corporation or association who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction thereof, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Three hundred Dollars (\$300.00), or by imprisonment for not more than Three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. This ordinance shall take effect from and after its passage.
