REGULATING THE HEIGHT OF AWNINGS, SHADES
AND BALCONIES.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, owning, occupying or having charge or control of any premises, to place, or cause to be placed, or suffer to remain upon said premises, any awning, shade or balcony, unless the same shall comply with the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 2. All awnings, shades and balconies shall be at least ten (10) feet above the level of the sidewalk, and a gutter shall thereon be formed to carry off the water to the line of the building and thence to the street. No gutter shall be required on cloth or canvas awnings or shades. The height of all movable canvas or cloth awnings or shades shall not be less than seven and one-half (7 1/2) feet above the sidewalk level.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and, upon conviction, shall be punished by a fine not exceeding Three hundred Dollars (\$300.00) or by imprisonment for not more than Three (3) months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately from and after its passage.
