Providing Rules and Regulations for Installing, Connecting, Wiring or otherwise Putting in Place Electrical Wires, Equipments or Apparatus.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:-

Section 1. The Town Electrician shall have supervision of the putting in of all electrical wiring, connections, appliances or apparatus, in or about any building in the Town of San Anselmo.

Section 2. No person, firm or corporation shall equip any building with wiring or apparatus, or make any alteration of, change in, or addition to any electric wiring or apparatus, without first notifying the Town Electrician in writing, and receiving from him a written permit to do the work, and when an equipment is found to conform to the rules and regulations adopted herein, the Town Electrician shall issue a certificate that the terms of this Ordinance have been complied with; but no such certificate shall be granted until the equipment is made to conform to the rules prescribed herein, and no current shall be turned on such installation or equipment, until certificate has been furnished in accordance with the terms of this Ordinance. The provisions of this Ordinance do not apply to central stations.

~~Section 3. The rules and regulations of the National Board of Fire Underwriters, as embodied in their "National Electrical Code" as the same are now established, together with any amendments and changes made therein from time to time, are hereby adopted as the rules and regulations and made a part of this Ordinance.~~

Section 4. If any part of any electrical equipment hereafter to be installed in or about any building in the town of San Anselmo shall be found to be dangerous to life or property, the Town Electrician shall have the right and power, and it shall be his duty, to notify the owner of the building or equipment to cease using electric current in such dangerous equipment, and to have the defects in said equipment repaired within a reasonable time, not exceeding ten days from date of notice.

Electrician is also authorized to give written notice to the company furnishing the current to any such dangerous equipment: cease to supply same until the defects are repaired. In a prosecution for a violation of the provision of this section each day's neglect to comply therewith shall be considered as taken as a separate violation.

Section 5. When upon application, inspection is made of the wiring or equipment in or about any building, the person, firm or corporation installing such equipment shall, before certificate is issued, pay to the said Town Electrician of this Town, for such inspection, the following fees, viz:

For permit .....	1.00
For each outlet at which current is used for lighting or use	
For each light fixture	.25
When wiring for motors: per motor	.50

For inspection of apparatus, for which no fee is herein prescribed, the Town Electrician may charge a fee not exceeding \$ .50 per hour for the time actually consumed in making the inspection; all such fees shall be collected by the Town Electrician.

Electrician is authorized to collect all services rendered by him under the provisions of this Ordinance.

Section 6. Any person, firm or corporation who shall or attempt to do electrical construction work, whether original work or alterations, without giving notice in writing to the Town Electrician, and without first obtaining a permit to do such work, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof be punished by a fine of not less than \$10. nor more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment ~~in the County Jail~~ ~~in the County Jail~~ for not more than fifty (50) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment, for each offense; and any person, firm or corporation who shall violate any of the provisions of this Ordinance, for which a penalty is not herein otherwise provided, and any occupant or owner of premises where electrical wiring or apparatus is used, or to be used, who shall prevent or interfere with the Town Electrician or any inspector in the discharge of his duties under this Ordinance, shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction thereof shall be pun-

ished by a fine of not less than \$5.00 nor more than \$100.00 or by imprisonment ~~for not more than fifty (50) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.~~

Section 7. This Ordinance shall not be construed to relieve from, or lessen the responsibility of any party owning, operating, controlling or installing any electrical equipment for damages to any one injured by any defect therein, nor shall the Town be held to assume any such liability by reason of the inspection authorized herein, or certificates issued hereunder.

Section 8. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force immediately.
