AMENDING SECTIONS 6 AND 7 OF ORDINANCE NO. 44, PROVIDING FOR THE SALE OF INTOXICATING LIQUORS AND REGULATING THE TRAFFIC THEREIN, AS AMENDED BY ORDINANCE NO. 60, AND ADDING TWO (2) NEW SECTIONS THEREIN TO BE KNOWN AS SECTIONS 6 1/2 AND 7 1/2.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. Section 5, of Ordinance No. 44, of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo, as amended by Ordinance No. 60, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(Section 5) The rate of license under the provisions of section 5, of Ordinance No. 44, shall be as follows:

For every person to whom a permit is granted to sell liquor under the provisions of section 3, of Ordinance No. 44, the sum of twenty-five Dollars (\$25.00), payable each quarter year, in advance, in lawful money of the United States, to the tax collector at his office in the Town of San Anselmo.

Section 2. Ordinance No. 44, of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be known as section 6 1/2, which said section 6 1/2 shall read as follows:

(Section 6 1/2) The rate of license under the provisions of section 2 of Ordinance No. 44, shall be as follows.

For every person to whom a permit is granted to sell liquor under the provisions of said Ordinance No. 44, the sum of One hundred Dollars (\$100.00), per annum, payable in advance, in lawful money of the United States, to the Tax Collector at his office in the Town of San Anselmo.

Section 3. Section 7, of Ordinance No. 44, of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo, as amended by Ordinance No. 60, is hereby amended to read as follows:

(Section 7) The license required by section 5, of this Ordinance, must be procured from the Tax Collector immediately before the commencement of the business herein required to be licensed, and shall be issued for the period of Three (3) months.

and not otherwise, and shall date from the time of the commencement of said business, or from the time of the expiration of the license next preceding. A separate commission and license must be obtained for each branch establishment or separate place of business.

Section 4. Ordinance No. 44, of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo, is hereby amended by adding a new section thereto to be known as section 7 1/2, which said section 7 1/2 shall read as follows:

(Section 7 1/2) The license required by Section 2 of said Ordinance No. 44, must be procured from the Tax collector immediately before the commencement of the business herein required to be licensed, and shall be issued for the calendar year in which said license is granted. A separate commission and license must be obtained for each branch establishment or separate place of business.

Section 5. Section 3, of Ordinance No. 60, is hereby expressly repealed.

Section 6. This Ordinance shall take effect and be in full force from and after the date of its passage.
