

ORDINANCE NO. 108

ESTABLISHING THE GRADE OF A PORTION OF TUNSTEAD AVENUE (FORMERLY ELM STREET).

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1.- The Official Curb Grade of Tunstead Avenue (formerly Elm Street) between San Anselmo Avenue (formerly Oak Street) and a point 450 feet west of San Anselmo Avenue, is hereby established in accordance with the following elevations.

At the intersection of Tunstead Avenue and San Anselmo Avenue, the elevation of Sub-Grade shall be 45.4 feet above the Official Base.

At a point 200. feet West of San Anselmo Avenue, the elevation of Sub-Grade shall be 46.3 feet above the Official Base.

At a point 400. feet West of San Anselmo Avenue, the elevation of Sub-Grade shall be 47.3 feet above the Official Base.

At a point 450. feet west of San Anselmo Avenue, the elevation of Sub-Grade shall be 48.3 feet above the Official Base.

True Grade lines shall connect the intersections above named.

Section 2. The Board of Trustees hereby declares that the immediate preservation of the public health and safety requires that a certain street of the Town of San Anselmo, to-wit: Tunstead Avenue, formerly Elm Street, be improved by paving the same without delay, and that the passage of this Ordinance is a condition precedent to the commencement of proceedings therefor; that, therefore, this Ordinance is declared to be, and is, an urgency measure as defined by that Act of the Legislature entitled, "An Act to Provide for Direct Legislation by Cities and Towns, including Initiative and Referendum," approved January 2nd, 1912, and is therefore not subject to the referendum provisions of said Act.

Section 4: This ordinance shall take effect immediately.
