

AMENDING SUBDIVISION 1 OF SECTION 2 OF ORDINANCE NO. 61, FIXING AND PRESCRIBING THE LICENSE TAX TO BE COLLECTED FROM PEOPLE DOING BUSINESS WITHIN IN THE CORPORATE LIMITS OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1.- Subdivision 1 of Section 2, of Ordinance No. 61, of the Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo, is hereby amended to read as follows:

1st. Every person, firm or corporation who, at a fixed place of business, sells any goods, wares or merchandise, or transacts, solicits or carries on any other secular business within the corporate limits of the Town of San Anselmo, shall pay a license tax of Twenty (\$20.00) Dollars per annum, payable in advance.

Every person, firm or corporation who transacts, conducts or solicits more than one line of business, or business calling shall pay a license tax of Twenty(\$20.00) Dollars per annum, payable in advance, for each and every separate and distinct line of business carried on, transacted or conducted by said person, firm or corporation.

Section 2 - This Ordinance shall take effect and be in force thirty(30) days from and after the date of its passage.
