

AN ORDINANCE PROHIBITING THE USE OF EXPLOSIVES FOR BLASTING ROCK IN THE OPERATION OF A QUARRY, WHEN SUCH QUARRY IS SITUATED WITHIN THREE HUNDRED (300) FEET OF ANY DWELLING HOUSE, AND PRESCRIBING THE PENALTY FOR VIOLATION THEREOF.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1.- It shall be unlawful for any person, company or corporation to use gun-powder, dynamite or other explosive for blasting rock in the operation of a quarry, when such quarry is situated within three hundred (300) feet of any dwelling house.

Section 2.- Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine not exceeding Two Hundred (\$200.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment not exceeding sixty (60) days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 3.- All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed.

Section 4.- This ordinance shall go into full force and effect January 1st, 1915
