

ORDINANCE NO. 131

AN ORDINANCE REQUIRING BARRIERS AND LIGHTS ON DANGEROUS OBSTRUCTIONS ON THE PUBLIC STREETS.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1.- Every person, firm or corporation having occasion to make excavations in any Public Streets or Sidewalks thereof while undertaking Building operations shall erect and maintain around such portion of the street or Sidewalk a good and substantial barrier; and every person, firm or corporation depositing or maintaining, or causing to be deposited or maintained, any building material of any kind whatsoever, or any debris, lumber or other material in any public street, sidewalk or place, shall display and maintain a red light at each end of each pile of such material or debris during the whole of each night from Sunset to Sunrise.

Section 2.- Every person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be fined not less than Ten (\$10.00) Dollars nor more than Fifty (\$50.00) Dollars, or by imprisonment in the Town Jail or County Jail of Marin County, one day for every Two(\$2.00) Dollars of the Fine so imposed and unpaid, or by both such Fine and imprisonment.
