

ORDINANCE NO. 136

PROHIBITING THE DESTRUCTION OR REMOVAL OF SURVEYORS MARKS OR MONUMENTS.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or corporation, to remove, deface, alter, injure or destroy any surveyor's monuments or marks placed or erected in any of the public streets, avenues, alleys, lanes or highways of the Town of San Anselmo; provided, that should the removal of any such monuments or marks become necessary in the opening of any public street, avenue, alley, lane or highway, or for the laying of any water main, pipe or sewer therein or construction of any sidewalk or public work thereon, any person, firm or corporation, performing such public work shall first notify the Town Engineer who shall supervise the removal or replacing of such monuments or marks.

Section 2. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon arrest and conviction thereof shall be punishable by a fine not to exceed One Hundred Dollars (\$100.00) or by imprisonment in the Town Jail not to exceed thirty days or by both such fine and imprisonment.
