

ORDINANCE NO. 138

AN ORDINANCE PROVIDING FOR THE IMPOSITION AND COLLECTION OF A LICENSE TAX, FOR THE PURPOSE OF REVENUE AND REGULATION, UPON VARIOUS KINDS OF BUSINESS AND OCCUPATIONS, TRANSACTED AND CARRIED ON THE THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. For the purpose of revenue and regulation a license tax is hereby imposed on the various kinds of business, trades and occupations hereinafter mentioned, and the license rates to be paid annually in advance by the owners or agents thereof are hereby fixed and established as follows:

1. Bakeries, \$10.00 per year.
2. Billiard and pool rooms (also permitting the sale of soft drinks, cigars and tobacco), \$10.00 per year.
3. Blacksmiths, \$10.00 per year.
4. Book agents, including solicitors for the sale of books, maps and pictures, ~~\$50.00 per year~~ \$2.50 per day
5. Bowling alleys, \$10.00 per year.
6. Boarding houses, \$10.00 per year.
7. Butcher shops, \$10.00 per year.
8. Cigar stores, (permitting the sale of candy and gum) \$10.00 per year.
9. Confectionery stores, \$10.00 per year.
10. Contractors, \$10.00 per year.
11. Cream and milk dealers, \$10.00 per year.
12. Doctors, including Christian Science practitioners, \$10.00 per year.
13. Druggists, \$10.00 per year.
14. Expressmen, \$10.00 per year.
15. Fortune Tellers, \$100.00 per year.
16. Garages, \$10.00 per year.
17. Hotels, \$10.00 per year.
18. Ice Dealers, \$10.00 per year.
19. Junk Dealers, \$10.00 per year.
20. Laundries, \$10.00 per year.
21. Livery stables, \$10.00 per year.
22. Markets, groceries, fruit and vegetable stores, \$10.00 per year.
23. Hardware stores, including sale of paints and oils, \$10.00 per year.
24. Merry-go-rounds, ~~\$50.00 per year~~ \$5.00 per day
25. Moving picture theatres, \$10.00 per year.
26. News Dealers, \$10.00 per year.
27. Oil Dealers, \$10.00 per year.
28. Peddlers, including peddlers of wood, fish, meat, fruit or vegetables, by one not having a fixed place of business within the town, provided that nothing herein shall apply to farmers or gardeners selling their own products exclusively, \$10.00 per year.
29. Plumbers, \$10.00 per year.
30. Printers, including publishers, \$10.00 per year.
31. Real Estate agents, \$10.00 per year.
32. Restaurants, \$10.00 per year
33. Sewing machine agents, \$10.00 per year.
34. Wood, Coal, Hay and Grain dealers, \$10.00 per year.

39.- Any business or concession not provided for in this ordinance shall pay a license fee of \$10⁰⁰ per year.

Section 2. The owner, manager or person in charge of any and every auction store, bankrupt store or any store or place where goods, wares or merchandise are advertised to be disposed of or exposed for sale for less than the original cost, shall pay a license tax of \$100.00 per year.

Section 3. Every person, firm, company or corporation doing business at more than one place in the Town of San Anselmo, or transacting more than one kind of business required to be licensed, either under the same roof or otherwise, shall take out a separate license for each business.

Section 4. No license shall be issued for a shorter term than one year.

Section 5. The Tax and License Collector shall, on the first Monday of each month settle with the Town Clerk for all moneys received under this ordinance, and immediately pay the same to the treasurer in accordance with law.

Section 6. Tax and License Collector shall report to the Clerk, every person, firm or corporation subject to a license tax under the terms of this ordinance and the Clerk shall prepare the necessary licenses therefor and deliver them with their respective amounts.

Section 7. It is hereby made the duty of the Tax and License Collector to cause complaint to be filed against all persons, firms or corporations violating any of the provisions of this ordinance.

Section 8. Every person, firm, Company or corporation violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be deemed guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not less than Ten Dollars and not exceeding One Hundred Dollars, or by imprisonment in the town jail not exceeding thirty days, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 9. This ordinance shall go into full force and effect ~~November 5th, 1915.~~ January 1st, 1916

SECTION 10.- All ordinances and parts of Ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby expressly repealed.
