

AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A BOARD OF HEALTH
IN AND FOR THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO, AND
PRESCRIBING THE DUTIES OF SAID BOARD.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. A Board of Health is hereby established in and for the Town of San Anselmo, to consist of five persons, one at least of whom shall be a practicing physician and the graduate of some reputable school of medicine and, one, if practicable, a civil engineer,

The members of the board shall hold their office at the pleasure of the Board of Trustees of said Town.

Section 2. It shall be the duty of the Board of Health to:

1. Supervise all matters pertaining to the sanitary condition of the Town, and make such rules and regulations relative thereto as are necessary and proper and not contrary to law.

2. Report to the Secretary of the State Board of Health at Sacramento, at such times as the State Board of Health may require:

- (a) The sanitary condition of the locality.
- (b) The number of deaths, with the cause of each, as near as can be ascertained, within its jurisdiction, during the preceding month.
- (c) The presence of epidemic or other dangerous, contagious or infectious diseases and such other matters, within their knowledge or jurisdiction, as the State Board of Health may require, and as required by the provisions of section 3061 of the Political Code of the State of California.

Section 3. It shall be the duty of the Board of Health to enforce within said Town all orders, rules and regulations concerning health and quarantine prescribed and directed by the State Board of Health, and to report or cause to be reported in writing to the State Board of Health on or before the 5th day of each month all infectious, contagious and communicable diseases in man or beast which come to its knowledge, upon blanks furnished by the State Board of Health, as required by the provisions of section 2984 of the Political Code of the State of California.

Section 4. The Board of Health of the Town of San Anselmo shall also have power to regulate the plumbing and drainage of buildings in said Town and shall prescribe such rules and regulations under which master or journeymen plumbers shall carry on their trades as in their judgement shall be deemed advisable, as required by the provisions of the act of the legislature entitled, "An Act to grant to Boards of Health and cities, and cities and counties, the power

to regulate the plumbing and drainage of buildings," approved March 18, 1883.

Section 5. The Board of Health shall also have power to provide for the examination, licensing and registration of master of journeymen plumbers as provided by the provisions of an act of the Legislature of the State of California entitled, "An act to grant to Boards of Health or Health Officers, in cities, and cities and counties, the power to regulate the plumbing and drainage of buildings, and to provide for the registration of plumbers," approved March 3, 1885.

I hereby approve the foregoing ordinance.
