

ORDINANCE NO. 183

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING CONNECTIONS WITH SEWERS
IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO.

The Board of Trustees of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 1. No person, firm or corporation shall connect any sewer with, or build or construct any sewer connecting with, or make any opening in, or make any connection whatsoever with, any sewer under the jurisdiction of the Town of San Anselmo without having first obtained a permit therefor from the Superintendent of Streets of said Town.


Section 2. All such permits shall be issued in accordance with any regulations prescribed therefor by the Board of Trustees of said Town.

Section 3. Any person, firm or corporation violating any of the provisions of this Ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor and upon conviction thereof shall be punished by a fine not exceeding one hundred dollars (\$100.) or by imprisonment not exceeding sixty (60) days or by both such fine and imprisonment; and the Superintendent of Streets shall be and is hereby authorized to prevent any such unauthorized connection with or opening in any such sewer under the jurisdiction of said Town and to disconnect and remove any such unauthorized connection and close up any such unauthorized opening, and the cost thereof not to


exceed Two hundred dollars (\$200.) shall be added to and become part of the fine imposed upon the person, firm or corporation found guilty of making such unauthorized connection or opening.

Section 4. This Ordinance shall be published once in the ~~Marin~~ San Anselmo Herald, a newspaper of general circulation printed and published in said Town, and shall go into effect upon its passage and approval.
