

ORDINANCE NO. 221 .

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 200 ENTITLED " AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING FIRE ZONES IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO," APPROVED SEPTEMBER 3, 1929, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW SECTION 2A EXCLUDING CERTAIN PROPERTY FROM FIRE ZONE NO. 1.

The City Council of the Town of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

Section 2a. ~~Lot 7, Block 2, of the Sunnyside Tract, as laid down and delineated in that certain map of Sunnyside Tract, filed in the office of the County Recorder of Marin County on November 8th, 1887, in Map book 1 at Page 12, and the south half of Lot 14, the south half of Lot 16, the southwest one-quarter of Lot 15 and the southeasterly one-quarter of Lot 15 of the Linda Vista Tract, as laid down and delineated in that certain map of Linda Vista Tract, filed in the office of the County Recorder of Marin County on August 5th, 1907, in Map book 2, Page 94, ~~is~~ <sup>are</sup> hereby withdrawn and excluded from Fire Zone No. 1 as established by Ordinance No. 200.~~

Section 2. This Ordinance shall be published once in the Marin Herald a weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in said Town of San Anselmo, and hereby designated for that purpose.
