

1 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 162, ENTITLED
2 "AN ORDINANCE DEFINING GARBAGE, PROVIDING FOR AND REGULATING
3 THE KEEPING, COLLECTING, AND DISPOSING THEREOF; MAKING IT
4 UNLAWFUL TO SPILL OR DEPOSIT GARBAGE IN PUBLIC PLACES OR
5 UPON PUBLIC STREETS AND ALLEYS; FIXING RATES FOR COLLECTION
6 OF GARBAGE; PROVIDING FOR THE LETTING OF AN EXCLUSIVE
7 CONTRACT FOR THE COLLECTION OF GARBAGE; PROVIDING A PENALTY
8 FOR THE VIOLATION OF ANY OF THE PROVISIONS OF THIS ORDINANCE;
9 AND REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH", ADOPTED
10 AUGUST 23, 1920, AS AMENDED, BY AMENDING SECTIONS 1 AND 2
11 THEREOF, AND BY REPEALING SECTION 5 THEREOF.

13 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO DO ORDAIN
14 AS FOLLOWS:

15 Section 1. Sections one (1) and two (2) of Ordinance No.
16 162 of the Town of San Anselmo, entitled "An ordinance defining
17 garbage, providing for and regulating the keeping, collecting,
18 and disposing thereof; making it unlawful to spill or deposit
19 garbage upon public streets and alleys; fixing rates for collection
20 of garbage; providing for the letting of an exclusive contract for
21 the collection of garbage; providing a penalty for the violation
22 of any of the provisions of this ordinance; and repealing all
23 ordinances in conflict herewith", adopted August 23, 1920, as
24 amended, are hereby amended to read as follows:

25 Section 1. Garbage as said word is used in this ordinance,
26 shall mean and include all garbage, swill, refuse, accumulation
27 of animal, fish, fowl, fruit or vegetable foodstuffs, and dead
28 animals. Garbage as said word is used in this ordinance, shall
29 also mean and include tin cans, scrap metal, ashes, cinders,
30 sweepings, chips, waste paper, paste board, grass, rags, straw,
31 wearing apparel, shoes, hats, gravel, manure, stones, bricks,
plaster, cement, crockery, bottles, glass, metals and metal
receptacles, and all other waste or refuse matter whatever,
whenever any thereof, or part thereof, is accumulated for disposal.

Section 2. It shall be unlawful for any person, firm or
corporation to keep, deposit, bury, or dispose of any garbage,
except as in this ordinance provided, in or upon any private
property, public street, alley, sidewalk, gutter, park, or
other public place whatsoever, or to throw the same in the bed
or upon the banks of any stream or creek in said Town, or in
or upon any of the waters thereof; and every person, firm, or
corporation in said town having the obligation of the disposal
of garbage as provided in this ordinance shall dispose of the
same only in the manner provided in this ordinance through the
official garbage collector of said Town, except, that any
person, firm or corporation may dispose of any accumulation of
leaves, papers, chips, grass, straw or other dry weeds, by
burning the same and then only upon written permission of the
Fire Marshall of said Town. Every tenant, lessee or occupant
of any private dwelling house or premises, and the keeper or
manager of every hotel, restaurant, eating house, boarding
house or other place where meals are furnished and of every
furnished flat or apartment house, and the owner or proprietor
of every business house or store shall have garbage collection
service by the official garbage collector of said Town at least
once each week, and oftener as ordered by the Health Officer of
said Town, and shall pay the said Official Garbage collector for
said garbage collection service, the monthly rates as herein-
after provided.

Section 2. Section 5 of said ordinance No. 162 is hereby repealed.

Section 3. This is an ordinance for the protection of the public peace, health and safety and one of urgency and shall take effect and become operative from and after its passage and approval. The facts constituting the urgency in this instance are that garbage is collecting in and upon various premises in said Town and are not being promptly removed or disposed of, thereby causing an infestation of rodents, and with great danger of the spread of contagious diseases, thereby endangering the health of the residents of this Town, and it is necessary for the proper protection and preservation of the health of said residents that this ordinance be passed and go into effect immediately upon its passage and approval.
