2 AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 190 ENTITLED
3 "AN ORDINANCE REGULATING AND ESTABLISHING THE LO-
4 CATION OF TRADES, INDUSTRIES, BUSINESSES, AND
5 DWELLINGS IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO, AND THE LO-
6 CATION OF BUILDINGS DESIGNED FOR SPECIFIC USES,
7 ESTABLISHING DISTRICTS OR ZONES AND THE BOUNDARIES
8 THEREOF FOR SAID PURPOSES, AND PROVIDING PENALTIES
9 FOR THE VIOLATION OF THIS ORDINANCE" --APPROVED
10 June 7, 1926, AS AMENDED, BY ADDING THERETO A NEW
11 SECTION 3J, EXTENDING THE COMMERCIAL DISTRICTS IN
12 SAID TOWN.

13 THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO DOES ORDAIN
14 AS FOLLOWS:

15 Section 1. A new section to be known as 3J is hereby added
16 to Ordinance No. 190 entitled, "An ordinance regulating and es-
17 tablishing the location of Trades, Industries, Businesses, and
18 Dwellings in the Town of San Anselmo, and the Location of Build-
19 ings designed for Specific Uses, Establishing Districts or Zones
20 and the Boundaries thereof for said Purposes, and Providing
21 Penalties for the Violation of this Ordinance", approved June 7,
22 1926, as Amended, said new section to read as follows:

23 Section 3J: The commercial Zone or district in said Town
24 of San Anselmo is hereby extended to include within its limits
25 all such territory or portion of said town as is included within
26 the following boundaries, to-wit:

27 Lot "B" as shown and delineated upon that certain map
28 entitled "Bunker Hill Tract," San Anselmo, Marin County,
29 California, as said Map is shown and recorded on file
30 in the office of the City Clerk of the Town of San
31 Anselmo, and also that portion of Warren Avenue, lying west
32 of said lot "B".

And in so far as said area has heretofore been within the
Residential District or zone, the same is withdrawn there from,
and hereby established as an extension of, and included within,
the Commercial District or Zone in said Town.

Section 2. This ordinance shall within 15 days after its
final passage and adoption, be published once in the San Anselmo
Herald, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and
circulated in said Town of San Anselmo, and hereby designated for
that purpose.

The foregoing ordinance was duly and regularly introduced
at a regular meeting of the City Council of the Town of San
Anselmo held in said Town of the 13th day of July, 1937, and
was thereafter at an adjourned regular meeting of said city
Council, held in said Town, on the 27th day of July, 1937, duly
