

ORDINANCE NO. 271

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 244 OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO, Entitled: "AN ORDINANCE CREATING AND ESTABLISHING A CIVIL SERVICE SYSTEM FOR THE SELECTION, EMPLOYMENT, CLASSIFICATION, ADVANCEMENT, SUSPENSION, DISCHARGE AND RETIREMENT OF APPOINTIVE OFFICERS AND EMPLOYEES OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO".

The City Council of the Town of San Anselmo does ordain as follows:

SECTION 1: A new section to be known as 8-A is hereby added to Ordinance No. 244 of the Town of San Anselmo, entitled: "An Ordinance Creating and Establishing a Civil Service System for the Selection, Employment, Classification, Advancement, Suspension, Discharge and Retirement of Appointive Officers and Employees of the Town of San Anselmo", which said new section reads as follows, to-wit:

SECTION 8-A: Notwithstanding any other provisions of this Ordinance and during the present state of war between the United States and Japan, Germany and Italy, and for a period of six (6) months thereafter, the City Council or other appointing officer may make temporary appointments to fill any position covered by the provisions of this Ordinance, which said temporary appointments may continue for the duration of said war and for six (6) months thereafter, and should any appointee be satisfactory in the performance of his duties and in his qualifications, and should there be a regular position open to be filled at the end of said time, said temporary appointee shall be entitled to any such appointment.

SECTION 2: The foregoing Ordinance shall, within fifteen (15) days after its final passage and adoption, be published once in the "San Anselmo Herald", a weekly newspaper of general circulation, published and circulated in the Town of San Anselmo, and hereby designated for

that purpose.

SECTION 3: This Ordinance is an urgency measure required for the immediate preservation of the public peace, health and safety of the people of the Town of San Anselmo, and the facts constituting such urgency are as follows: because of the present war conditions and high salaries being paid by defense industries, several employees of the Town of San Anselmo have left the employment of said Town, or have threatened to leave; it will be impossible to fill such vacancies expeditiously under the present provisions of Ordinance No. 244, and therefore this Ordinance shall be in full force and effect immediately upon its final passage and adoption.
