

ORDINANCE NO. 313

Rec'd in Jail - 4/17/45

AN ORDINANCE REGULATING THE DISPENSING
OF INFLAMMABLE LIQUIDS TO THE PUBLIC

The City Council of the Town of San Anselmo does ordain as follows:

Section 1. As used in this Ordinance, the term "inflammable liquids" includes all liquids with a flash point below 110° Fahrenheit, as determined in a "Saybolt Electric Open Cup Tester," and all liquids which emit a flammable vapor and with flash point at or above 110° Fahrenheit, as determined in a "Saybolt Electric Open Cup Tester."

Section 2. In the Town of San Anselmo, inflammable liquids, as hereinabove described, shall be delivered from dispensing devices only by the *Station* operators of such devices, their employees or authorized representatives; and when unattended, all pumps and other facilities for the delivery of inflammable liquids shall be locked, or other effective provision made to prevent access to supplies of such inflammable liquids.

Section 3. No person, save and except the operator, his employee or authorized representative shall dispense inflammable liquids from pumps or other facilities, and it shall be unlawful for any other person to dispense inflammable liquid from any pump or other facility in the Town of San Anselmo. It shall be unlawful for any operator, his agent or authorized representative to permit any unauthorized person to dispense inflammable liquids from any pump or other facility for delivery of inflammable liquids.

Section 4. Any person violating any of the provisions of this ordinance shall be guilty of a misdemeanor, and upon conviction therefor shall be punished by a fine not to exceed \$500.00 or by imprisonment in the County Jail for a period not to exceed six months, or by both such fine and imprisonment.

Section 5. Within fifteen days after its final passage and adoption, this ordinance shall be posted in three public places in the Town of San

Anselmo, which said places are hereby designated as follows, to-wit:

- (a) Bulletin Board, San Anselmo Post Office,
- (b) Bulletin Board, San Anselmo Library,
- (c) Bulletin Board, San Anselmo City Hall,

and shall be in full force and effect thirty days from and after its final passage and adoption.

The foregoing Ordinance was duly introduced at a regular meeting of the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo, held in said Town on the 12th day of April, 1949, and was thereafter at a regular meeting of the City Council held in said Town on the 10 day of May, 1949, duly passed and adopted by the following vote:
