ORDINANCE NO. 385

"AN ORDINANCE CHANGING THE CORPORATE NAME OF THE MUNICIPAL CORPORATION TO THE "CITY OF SAN ANSELMO" INSTEAD OF THE "TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO."

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO, CALIFORNIA, DO HEREBY ORDAIN AS FOLLOWS:

SECTION 1. The word "town" is hereby eliminated from the corporate name of San Anselmo and in its place the word "city" is substituted, pursuant to the authority of Section 34509 of the Government Code of the State of California.

SECTION 2. Upon adoption of this ordinance the City Clerk Shall file with the Secretary of State and the Marin County Board of Supervisors, a statement showing the adoption of this ordinance. Upon filing the said statements the word "city" shall thereafter be substituted for the word "town" in the corporate name,

SECTION 3. This ordinance shall be published once in the "San Anselmo Times" a weekly newspaper of general circulation published in the Town of San Anselmo, which newspaper is hereby designated for that purpose. This ordinance shall be in full force and effect thirty (30) days from and after its final passage.




