AN ORDINANCE REPEALING SECTION 4 (a) ii (Tax Exemptions of Public Agencies) of Ordinance No. 402 entitled "AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY OF SAN ANSELMO IMPOSING A LICENSE TAX FOR THE PRIVILEGE OF SELLING TANGIBLE PERSONAL PROPERTY AT RETAIL, PROVIDING FOR PERMITS TO RETAILERS, PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTING AND PAYING OF SUCH TAX, AND PRESCRIBING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATIONS OF THE PROVISIONS HEREOF.

The City Council of the City of San Anselmo do ordain as follows:

1. Section 4 (a) ii of San Anselmo Ordinance No. 402 is hereby repealed in its entirety.
2. The effective date of said repeal shall be January 1, 1957.
3. ~~Section 5~~ PUBLICATION. This Ordinance shall be published once in full within fifteen days from and after its final passage in the SAN ANSELMO TIMES, a weekly newspaper printed, published and circulated in the City of San Anselmo, and hereby designated for that purpose.
