ORDINANCE NO. 642

ORDINANCE CALLING AND ORDERING SPECIAL BOND ELECTION
AND PROVIDING FOR THE GIVING OF NOTICE THEREOF

The Council of the City of San Anselmo does ordain as follows:

WHEREAS, in the judgment of the City Council of the City of San Anselmo, Marin County, State of California, it is advisable to call and hold a special bond election in said City and to submit thereat to the electors of said City as one proposal the question whether or not bonds of the City shall be issued to make the outlays as hereinafter designated; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of said City has heretofore, on the 9th day of January, 1973, adopted its resolution determining that the public interest and necessity demand the acquisition of a municipal improvement, to wit, the acquisition of the fee title or any lesser interest or right in real property constituting "open space" or "open area" as such terms are defined in Section 6954 of the Government Code of the State of California; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Anselmo deems it necessary to incur a bonded indebtedness for the purposes hereafter set forth.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the City Council of the City of San Anselmo, Marin County, State of California, as follows:

1. The recitals hereinabove set forth are true and correct, and the City Council so finds and determines.
2. A special bond election shall be and the same is hereby called to be held, and the same will be held, in the City of San Anselmo, on Tuesday, April 17, 1973, at which election there shall be submitted to the qualified electors residing within said City as one proposal the question whether or not bonds of the City shall be issued to make the outlays set forth in the following measure, to wit:

ORIGINAL

MEASURE:

(Acquisition of Open Space)

Shall the City of San Anselmo, Marin County, State of California, incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of \$500,000.00 for the purpose of raising money for the acquisition of "open space" or "open area" for the use and enjoyment of the people of San Anselmo?

3. The election shall be called and notice thereof shall be given by publication of this ordinance once a day for at least seven (7) days in a newspaper published at least six days a week in the City, or once a week for two weeks in a newspaper published less than six days a week in the City; and the City Clerk is hereby authorized and directed to cause such notice to be given. Publication of this ordinance shall constitute the notice of said special bond election and no other notice need be given, in accordance with Section 43611 of the Government Code of the State of California.

4. The election shall be held and conducted in accordance with this ordinance and with applicable laws of the State of California.

INSTRUCTIONS TO VOTERS: To vote on the measure, stamp a cross (X) in the voting square after the word "YES" or after the word "NO." All marks except the cross (X) are forbidden. All distinguishing marks or erasures are forbidden and make the ballot void. If you wrongly stamp, tear or deface this ballot, return it to the Inspector of Election and obtain another. On absent voter ballots mark a cross (X) with pen or pencil.

MEASURE SUBMITTED TO VOTE OF VOTERS

MEASURE: Shall the City of San Anselmo, Marin County, State of California, incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of \$500,000.00 for the purpose of raising money for the acquisition of "open space" or "open area" for the use and enjoyment of the people of San Anselmo?

6. Each voter to vote for the measure hereby submitted and for incurring said bonded indebtedness shall stamp a cross (X) in the blank space opposite the words "BONDS - YES" on the ballot to the right of said measure, and to vote against said measure and against incurring said indebtedness shall stamp a cross (X) in the blank space opposite the words "BONDS-NO" on the ballot to the right of said measure. Absent voter ballots setting forth said measure shall be issued to qualified electors residing within the area entitled thereto, in the manner provided by law. Every voter residing within the area for the period requisite to enable him to vote at a general election shall be entitled to vote in the election and shall receive a ballot in the form set forth in Section 5 hereof.

7. The maximum term of bonds to be issued pursuant to the aforesaid measure shall not exceed twenty-five (25) years.

8. The annual rate of interest to be paid on bonds issued pursuant to the aforesaid measure shall not exceed seven per cent (7%) per annum.

9. The polls shall open for said special bond election at 7:00 o'clock A.M. on April 17, 1973, and shall remain open until 8:00 o'clock P.M. on said day, at which time the polls shall be closed.

10. The returns of said election shall be canvassed by the City Clerk of the City of San Anselmo in accordance with the provisions of the law applicable thereto.

11. The estimated total cost of the "open space" or "open area" to be acquired is \$500,000.00 to be funded by a General Obligation bond issue financed over a period of twenty-five (25) years.

12. The estimated cost stated herein of the public improvement includes:

A. Legal or other fees incidental to or connected with the authorization, issuance and sale of the bonds.


B. The costs of printing the bonds and other costs and expenses incidental to or connected with the authorization, issuance and sale of the bonds.

13. The City Council proposes to issue and dispose of bonds of the City for the purpose of making the outlays set forth in the measure set out in Section 2 hereof, in accordance with this ordinance, and otherwise as required or permitted by law, if at the election two-thirds of the votes cast are in favor of the issuance of the bonds.
