RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
, COUNTY OF MARIN, STATE OF CALIFORNIA

WHEREAS, the CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY RECREATION ENABLING ACT of 1939, was enacted for the purpose of promoting and preserving the health and general welfare of the people of the state and to cultivate the development of good citizenship by provision for adequate programs of community recreation, and said Act authorizes the cities, counties and public-school districts to organize, promote and conduct such programs of community recreation as will contribute to the attainment of general educational and recreational objectives for children and adults of the State of California, and

WHEREAS, the said Act further authorizes governing bodies of any two or more public authorities to cooperate with each other and with the federal government or any department thereof to carry out the purposes of said Act and to that end to enter in agreements with each other and to do any and all things necessary or convenient to aid in carrying out the purposes of said Act, and

WHEREAS, this Council is advised that funds may be made available by the federal government to provide recreational facilities in defense areas, including the area comprised by the County of Marin and the City of

WHEREAS, the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF MARIN by its resolution numbered 293 passed and adopted on the 23rd day of February, 1943, designated and appointed the MARIN COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION as the Defense Recreation Committee for the County of Marin to exercise the powers granted by said Act and to carry out the purposes of said Act and to receive and expend the funds for recreation received by said County under the terms of the Lanham Act as amended and passed by the Congress of the United States for the purpose of promoting such recreational program, and

WHEREAS, it is the desire of this Council to cooperate with the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF MARIN to carry out the purposes of the CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY RECREATION ENABLING ACT of 1939 and to that end to agree with the said Board of Supervisors of said County that the said MARIN COUNTY PLANNING COMMISSION shall also be appointed and designated by this Council as the Defense Recreation Committee for the City of for the limited purpose of making application for and receiving such funds as may be available to the City of for recreation under the terms of the Lanham Act above referred to, provided however that all of said funds thus received by and allocated to the City of under the terms of the application for Federal grant, be expended in their entirety upon recreational facilities within the said City of , without deductions for administrative or other expenses.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this Council does desire and agree with the BOARD OF SUPERVISORS OF THE COUNTY OF MARIN to do any and all things necessary or convenient to aid and cooperate in carrying out the purpose of the said CALIFORNIA COMMUNITY ENABLING ACT OF 1939, and does further designate and appoint the PLANNING COMMISSION of the COUNTY OF MARIN as the Defense Recreation Committee for the City of _____ for the limited purpose of making application for, receiving and expending all such funds as may be available to the said City of _____ for such recreational purposes under the terms of the Lanham Act above referred to, upon condition however that the said funds received under said Act specifically for the City of _____, shall be expended by said Committee for recreational purposes within the confines of the said City of _____.

RESOLUTION DECLARING PUBLIC NUISANCE UNDER ORD. 251.

WHEREAS the Building Inspector of the Town of San Anselmo has filed with the City Clerk an affidavit relating to the condition of premises located at 231 LAUREL Ave - v described as Lot 103-Koss Valley Park #v, and relating to the giving of notice respecting a proposed hearing thereon, to said affidavit reference is hereby made for further particulars; and

WHEREAS this is the time and place for the hearing of evidence upon said matter; and such evidence having been fully heard and considered;

NOW THEREFOR THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO DOES RESOLVE, FIND AND DETERMINE AS FOLLOWS:

1. It is hereby found as a fact that the notices required to be given under section 2 of said ordinance number 251, as amended, have been given in the manner and form therein required and as required by law and as specified in said affidavit, which latter is hereby incorporated herein by reference;

2. That the following persons appeared and testified upon such hearing: N.E. Marcucci - Building Inspector. : that no other persons appeared or offered any testimony or other evidence upon such hearing;

3. That this Council should, and it does hereby declare the property or structure upon the property above referred to, to be a public nuisance and the owner thereof is directed and ordered to abate said nuisance within thirty days from and after the adoption of this resolution, by having said building or structure properly reconstructed or repaired or by having the same razed or removed;

4. That said owner be and he/she is hereby notified that if said nuisance is not so abated, said building or structure will

be razed or removed by the Building Inspector of the Town of San Anselmo, and the expense thereof will be made a lien upon the lot or parcel of land from which it was removed.
