IN THE MATTER OF THE PROPOSED CLOSING UP AND ABANDONMENT OF  
PORTIONS OF OAK AVENUE IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO

RESOLUTION OF INTENTION

NO. 400

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo that the public interest and convenience requires that the certain hereinafter particularly described portions of OAK AVENUE in the said Town of San Anselmo be closed and abandoned; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that it is the intention of the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo to close and abandon portions of OAK AVENUE more particularly described as follows:

All that certain piece of part of Oak Avenue situate and being in the Town of San Anselmo, County of Marin, State of California, described as follows:

BEGINNING at the North East corner of Lot Number One (1) in Block Number Sixteen (16) as shown and so designated upon a certain map entitled "Map No. 2 Sunnyside Tract, San Anselmo Valley, Marin County, Surveyed and drawn by Geo. M. Dodge, C. E., 1892", filed May 11th, 1892, in Map Book 1, page 67, in the office of the County Recorder of the County of Marin, State of California and running along the boundary of said Lot Number One, South 61 degrees 58 minutes West, 25 feet; thence leaving said boundary of said Lot Number One and running North 10 degrees 58 minutes 30 seconds East, 31.47 feet to the Westerly boundary of Lot Number Four, as said lot is shown and designated on the aforementioned Map No. 2 Sunnyside Tract; thence running along the Westerly boundary of said Lot Number Four, South 40 degrees 01 minute East, 25 feet to the point of beginning.

Said closing and abandonment of said portions of OAK AVENUE shall be done and made in the manner and in accordance with the provisions of Section 3220, et seq, of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that said above particularly described property is the only property deemed necessary to take for such improvement, and forms the exterior boundaries of the property affected

thereby; that no damages, costs, or expenses will be incurred or accrue on account of the closing and abandoning of said portions of OAK AVENUE aforesaid, wherefore no assessment will be necessary and no district of lands will have to be established for assessment purposes; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that all persons objecting to the closing up or abandoning of said portions of street are hereby required to file their written objections of the same in the office of the City Clerk of said Town of San Anselmo as required by law, to-wit: within ten (10) days after the expiration of publication of the "Notice of Public Works" to be published herein; and,

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of this Council be and he is hereby directed to submit to the Superintendent of Streets, a copy of this resolution and the said Superintendent of Streets is hereby directed to give notice of said contemplated closing and abandonment of said portions of said OAK AVENUE in the manner provided by law and to cause notice to be published in the San Anselmo Herald, a weekly newspaper of general circulation, duly published in the Town of San Anselmo and hereby designated for said purpose, as required by statute.

The foregoing resolution was duly passed and adopted this 23 day of April, 1946, by the following vote:
