

RESOLUTION NO. 401


DIRECTING PUBLICATION OF NOTICE OF THE
SPECIAL MUNICIPAL BOND ELECTION TO BE
HELD IN THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO ON MAY
28, 1946.

WHEREAS, the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo has heretofore adopted its Resolution of Public Interest and Necessity determining that the public interest and necessity demand the acquisition, construction and completion of the municipal improvement therein specified and intends to call and hold a special municipal bond election on May 28, 1946, in accordance with the provisions of an ordinance calling and providing for said election this day introduced and read before the City Council of said Town of San Anselmo; and

WHEREAS, it is advisable that notice of said election be forthwith given,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo, as follows:

Section 1. The Clerk of the Town of San Anselmo is hereby authorized and directed to publish once in "San Anselmo Herald", a Notice of said special municipal bond election in substantially the following form, to wit: _____



"NOTICE OF ELECTION

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a special municipal election will be held in the Town of San Anselmo, County of Marin, State of California, on Tuesday, the 28th day of May, 1946. The following measure will be submitted at the election:

PROPOSITION: Shall the Town of San Anselmo incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of \$75,000 for the object and purpose of acquiring, constructing and completing the following municipal improvement to wit: A municipal swimming pool and aquatic gymnasium to be located in the San Anselmo public park and playground, together with buildings, lighting equipment, water treatment facilities, sanitary and sewer facilities necessary therefor, and other works, property or structures necessary or convenient for a municipal swimming pool for recreational purposes of San Anselmo?

There will be four (4) voting precincts for the purpose of holding the election, consisting of a consolidation of the regular election precincts established for holding state or county elections, as follows:

CONSOLIDATED PRECINCT "A"

(consisting of Precincts Nos. 215, 216, 217, 218, 219, 220 and 222, within the Town of San Anselmo, as now established of record by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin, State of California, for general State and County election purposes).

The polling place thereof shall be at the City Hall on San Anselmo Avenue at Tunstead Avenue, San Anselmo, California.

CONSOLIDATED PRECINCT "B"

(consisting of Precincts Nos. 221, 226 and 227 within the Town of San Anselmo, as now established of record by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin, State of California, for general State and County election purposes).

The polling place thereof shall be at the Red Hill School, on the northeasterly side of Sir Francis Drake Boulevard between Sonoma Avenue and Los Angeles Boulevard, San Anselmo, California.

CONSOLIDATED PRECINCT "C"

(Consisting of Precincts Nos. 223, 224, 228 and 230 within the Town of San Anselmo, as now established of record by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin, State of California, for general State and County election purposes).

The polling place thereof shall be at the Yolansdale School on Elm Avenue at San Anselmo Avenue, San Anselmo, California.


CONSOLIDATED PRECINCT "D"

(consisting of Precincts Nos. 225, 229, 231 and 232 within the Town of San Anselmo, as now established of record by the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin, State of California, for general State and County Election purposes).

The polling place thereof shall be at Falk's Garage on Butterfield Road at Sir Francis Drake Boulevard, San Anselmo, California.

The polls will be open between the hours of seven o'clock A. M. and seven o'clock P.M.

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the following measure is to be voted on at the special municipal election to be held in the Town of San Anselmo, County of Marin, State of California, on Tuesday, the 28th day of May, 1946, to wit:

PROPOSITION: Shall the Town of San Anselmo incur a bonded indebtedness in the principal amount of \$75,000 for the object and purpose of acquiring, constructing and completing the following municipal improvement to wit: A municipal swimming pool and aquatic gymnasium to be located in the San Anselmo public park and playground, together with buildings, lighting equipment, water treatment facilities, sanitary and sewer facilities necessary therefor, and other works, property or structures necessary or convenient for a municipal swimming pool for recreational purposes of San Anselmo?




