

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO DESIGNATING A SECTION OF SAN ANSELMO AVENUE A "NO PARKING ZONE" FOR A LIMITED TIME, AND DESIGNATING A SECTION OF MAGNOLIA AVENUE AND LIBRARY PLACE AS PARKING AREAS FOR A LIMITED TIME.

WHEREAS, Alberts Store Building at 540 San Anselmo Avenue, Town of San Anselmo, is being renovated, and


WHEREAS, the street in front of said premises is now zoned for parking of automobiles; that said parking during the renovation of the said premises is apparently dangerous to persons parking in front of said building not only to the vehicles so parked but personally to the people using said vehicles, and

WHEREAS, the street area on Magnolia Avenue from San Anselmo Avenue to the beginning of the Parking Lot thereon is available for emergency parking as is also that section of ~~Library Place~~ ^{CITY HALL} ~~Place~~, and on the ~~westerly~~ ^{CITY HALL} side thereof, adjacent to the side of Rossi Brothers Pharmacy, and

WHEREAS, Public interest, safety and welfare require that during the renovating of the said building the street area immediately in front thereof be zoned "no parking" until the reconstruction is completed;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED: That the City Council of the Town of San Anselmo hereby designates the easterly side of San Anselmo Avenue in front of Alberts Store Building at 540 San Anselmo Avenue, a NO PARKING area; that said area shall continue to be a no-parking area until January 30th 1951 or until the said building project is completed whichever event shall first occur, and

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED, that during the time the area in front of Alberts Store is zoned "No Parking" as aforesaid, that Magnolia Avenue from San Anselmo Avenue to the beginning of the Parking Lot, and on the same side of the street, be zoned for parking; that during the same time the ~~westerly~~ ^{CITY HALL} side of ~~Library Place~~ ^{AVE} alongside of Rossis Pharmacy Building be zoned for parking.




