RESOLUTION NO. 771

CITY OF SAN ANSELMO

RESOLUTION OF PRELIMINARY DETERMINATION THAT THE
PUBLIC CONVENIENCE AND NECESSITY REQUIRE IMPROVE-
MENTS IN ASSESSMENT DISTRICT NO. 1959-1, CITY OF
SAN ANSELMO, MARIN COUNTY, CALIFORNIA

BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the City of San Anselmo, County of Marin, California, as follows:

1. That there have been filed with the City Council petitions signed by the owners of more than sixty per cent (60%) of the area of the property within the boundaries of the proposed assessment district outlined on the map annexed to said petitions and marked "Exhibit A" therein, requesting that special assessment proceedings be instituted to construct improvements within the boundaries of said district and that the cost and expenses of said work and improvement should be assessed upon the property within the boundaries of said district.

2. Preliminary determination is hereby made that the public convenience and necessity require that the following improvements be made and paid for by special assessments levied upon the property benefited and that necessary special assessment proceedings should be taken therefor.

3. The nature of the proposed improvements consists of the grading and construction of curbs and gutters, construction of valley gutters and paving.

4. The cost and expenses of the payment of said improvements will be borne by an assessment district which shall be known and designated as "Assessment District No. 1959-1, City of San Anselmo, Marin County, California", and the boundaries of said district are hereby designated to be the boundaries as shown on the map which is attached to the original petition on file herein and marked "Exhibit A" therein.

5. Inasmuch as the owners of more than sixty per cent (60%) of the area of the property within the boundaries of said

proposed assessment district have signed a petition for said work and said property owners have waived any proceedings required by the Special Assessment Investigation, Limitation and Majority Protest Act of 1931 of the State of California, therefore said Act shall not apply to said proceedings.

6. The City Council hereby finds that the construction of said improvements is feasible; that the properties to be assessed will be able to carry the burden of the proposed assessment; that in the opinion of this City Council the contemplated improvement is one in which the probable assessments will not exceed the limitations set up in Division 4, Part 2, of the Streets and Highways Code of the State of California.
