RESOLUTION NO. 969

RESOLUTION OF THE CITY OF SAN ANSELMO DECLARING ITS INTENTION TO VACATE PORTION OF THE ALAMEDA AND OAKLAND AVENUE.

WHEREAS, on August 6, 1963 the Planning Commission of the City of San Anselmo did recommend for approval the final Map of Indian Rock Subdivision Unit One, which map indicates portions of certain heretofore delineated streets in Short Ranch Subidivision Units 1 and 2 to be obsolete and no longer needed for thoroughfare.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that this City Council purusant to the Street Vacation Action of 1941 (Streets and Highways Code, Section 8300, et seq.) hereby declares its intention to vacate that portions of The Alameda and Oakland Avenue which portions are described as follows:

1. That portion of The Alameda as said The Alameda is delineated on that certain map entitled Short Ranch Subdivision One, Marin County as said map was filed on May 9, 1912 in book 4 of maps at page 19 thereof, that lies easterly of a point on the center line of said The Alameda that is 400 feet easterly of lot No. 103 of said subdivision.

2. That portion of Oakland Avenue as said Oakland Avenue is delineated on that certain map entitled Short Ranch Dubdivision Two, Marin County as said map was filed on July 3, 1912 in book 4 of maps at page 22 thereof that lies northerly of a point described as follows: beginning at the north east corner of lot 317 of said Short Ranch, Subdivision Two, thence south 78 degrees 39 minutes 32 seconds west 401.12 feet, and north 11 degrees 08 minutes west 66.53 feet, and north 30 degrees 34 minutes east 31.32 feet to said point.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that Tuesday, the 24th day of September, 1963, at 8:00 o'clock P.M., at the Chambers of the City Council, City Hall, San Anselmo, California, is hereby fixed as the time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting to said proposed vacation;

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of this Council be and she is hereby directed to give notice of the adoption of this resolution, pursuant to Streets and Highways Code, Section 8322.
