A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF
THE CITY OF SAN ANSELMO REQUESTING
THE POSTMASTER GENERAL OF THE UNITED
STATES NOT TO REMOVE THE POST OFFICE
FROM THE CENTRAL BUSINESS AREA OF
SAN ANSELMO

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF SAN ANSELMO
DOES RESOLVE AS FOLLOWS:

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of San Anselmo has been advised that the present post office facilities are becoming critically inadequate because of insufficient space and parking and that upon the termination of the present lease the Post Office Department will necessarily have to obtain larger and more suitable quarters in order to serve the City of San Anselmo, and

WHEREAS, numerous citizens of San Anselmo have petitioned the City Council to take such action as may be reasonable to assure that any new post office will be located in the central business district area of San Anselmo, and

WHEREAS, the Postmaster of San Anselmo has appeared before the City Council and has explained in detail the Post Office problems with respect to space requirements,

NOW, THEREFORE, it is RESOLVED as follows:

That it is the opinion of the City Council that the best interests and welfare of the citizens of San Anselmo require that the United States Post Office serving San Anselmo should be in the central business district area, if possible. That the removal of the post office from the central district business area will discommode the majority of the citizens of San Anselmo and particularly the merchants of the City.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be forwarded to the Postmaster General of the United

States with another copy to the Postmaster of the City of San Anselmo.
