RESOLUTION NO. 1182

A RESOLUTION OF INTENTION TO ABANDON A PORTION OF
OAKLAND AVENUE RIGHT-OF-WAY IN INDIAN ROCK SUBDIVISION
UNIT ONE

Good cause appearing therefor, it is hereby resolved,
pursuant to Sections 8322 and 8323 of the Government Code
of the State of California, as follows:

1. That public interest, welfare and convenience re-
quire that the following described street right-of-way be
abandoned:

That portion of Oakland Avenue, being
a certain parcel shown as "Parcel C",
on the map of Indian Rock Subdivision
Unit One, recorded in Book 12 of Maps
at page 91, Marin County Records.

That a map is on file in the office of the City Clerk showing,
in particular, the right-of-way to be abandoned.

2. That Tuesday, January 23, 1968, at the hour of
8:00 P.M., at the City Council Chambers, is hereby fixed as the
time and place for hearing all persons interested in or objecting
to the proposed vacation.

3. Notice of the hearing on the intention to abandon
or vacate the said right-of-way shall be published once in
the REPORTER, a newspaper
of general circulation in the City of San Anselmo, within
fifteen (15) days from passage of this resolution.

4. The right-of-way to be abandoned shall be posted

conspicuously, pursuant to Section 8322 of the Government Code of the State of California.
