RESOLUTION NO. 2032

A RESOLUTION OF INTENT TO ABANDON MOSS LANE

WHEREAS, the Town Council of the Town of San Anselmo finds that the hereinafter described portion of public right-of-way is not presently needed for any public use and no public use therefor will be required in the future; that said portion of right-of-way is surplus to the present and prospective needs of the public and such abandonment is in conformance with the San Anselmo General Plan;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED;

1. That pursuant to the provisions of Section 8300 et. seq. of the California Streets and Highways Code, the Town Council declares its intention to abandon and vacate the following described portion of Moss Lane:

A portion of that certain undeveloped right-of-way entitled Moss Lane, beginning at the northwest corner of Lot 14, Block 12 as shown on the Amended Map of Sequoia Park, Section No. 2, recorded in Map Book 4 at Page 21, Marin County Records; thence in a southerly direction along the westerly line of Lot 14 to the southwest corner of said Lot; thence in a northwesterly direction across Moss Lane to the southeasterly corner of Lot 3, Block 10, as shown on said Map of Sequoia Park; thence in a northerly direction along the easterly line of Lot 3 to the northeast corner of said Lot; thence in an northeasterly direction across Moss Lane to the point of beginning.

2. That reference is made to the map on file in the office of the Town Engineer which delineates the area to be vacated.

3. That a public hearing on the proposed vacation will be held at 8:00 p.m. Tuesday, June 25, 1985 in Town Hall Council Chambers, at which time and place all persons interested for or against said vacation will be heard.

4. That this resolution shall be published once in full in the Ross Valley Reporter, a newspaper of general circulation published in the Town of San Anselmo, within fifteen days of its passage.

5. Notice of street vacation shall be posted conspicuously along the line of the portion of right-of-way proposed to be vacated at least ten (10) days before the date set for hearing, in at least three (3) placed not more than three hundred (300) feet apart. The said posted notice shall state the passage of

the Resolution of Intention and the time and place of the public hearing.
