RESOLUTION NO. 3080

RESOLUTION APPROVING THE FIVE-YEAR FEDERAL AID URBAN PROGRAM
COMMENCING FY 1989-90
RECOMMENDED BY THE MARIN COUNTY URBAN SYSTEM COMMITTEE

WHEREAS, the Town of San Anselmo desires to continue to participate in the Federal Aid Urban program for funding approved transportation projects as authorized by the Federal Highway Act of 1973 and succeeding amendments; and

WHEREAS, the Federal Highway Act, the State Transportation Board, and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission require that a program of projects approved for Federal Aid Urban funding be established by a countywide committee consisting of representatives from each City, the County, Transit District, Caltrans, Golden Gate Bridge District, and the Metropolitan Transportation Commission; and

WHEREAS, the Board of supervisors has approved procedures for review of the Federal Aid Urban program and in accord with these procedures, the Marin County Urban System Committee did meet to review the program and the new projects which have been submitted for consideration as part of a five-year program; and

WHEREAS, the Marin County Urban System Committee did recommend approval of a five-year Federal Aid Program on December 14, 1988;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Town Council of the Town of San Anselmo does hereby approve said Committee recommended five-year Federal Aid Urban Program of projects beginning FY 1989-90 as specified in Exhibit "A" attached hereto.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that copies of this resolution be forwarded to the Board of Supervisors of the County of Marin for approval as the properly adopted Marin County Federal Aid Urban System Program.
