RESOLUTION NO. 3299

A RESOLUTION OF THE SAN ANSELMO TOWN COUNCIL ADOPTING RULES
AND REGULATIONS FOR PUBLIC PARKS AND PLAYGROUNDS

RESOLVED that the San Anselmo Town Council, pursuant to Section 11-1-2 of the San Anselmo Municipal Code, hereby adopts the following rules and regulations for use and occupancy of public parks and playgrounds located within the Town:

1. Hours of use. No person may be in a park or playground between 1/2 hour after sundown and 1/2/ hour before sunrise unless attending a function sanctioned by the Parks and Recreation Department.
2. Care in use. No person may damage, destroy, deface or remove any equipment, structure, sign, fence, wall, tree, plant or turn in any park or playground. No person may place a rope swing or similar attachment or wood structure on any tree in any park or playground. No signs or structure of any kind may be erected in a park or playground without written permission of the Park and Recreation Director.
3. Commercial use prohibited. No person or group shall use any park or playground for commercial purposes.
4. Fires. No person shall light or maintain any fire in any park or playground unless in a stove, barbecue, or fire circle provided for such purpose.
5. Motor vehicles. No motor vehicle may be driven or parked in any park or playground except in an established parking area. No motor vehicle may be parked overnight in park or playground parking areas. No motor driven model may be operated in a park or playground without permission of the Parks Superintendent.
6. Animals restricted. No person shall ride a horse or other animal in any park or playground except in areas designated and posted for such use. Dogs are allowed in public parks, under the conditions described in the attached Exhibit "A."
7. Amplified sound. Amplified sound equipment may be used in a park or playground only in accordance with the provisions of Chapter 7 of Title 4 of the San Anselmo Municipal Code, an in conjunction with a group permit under Section 9 of these rules and regulations.
8. Golf. No person shall play or practice golf or use golf clubs in any area of a park or playground not designated and posted for such use.

9. Group use. No group of twenty-five (25) or more persons may use any park or playground without written permission of the Parks Superintendent. Application for group reservations must be made at least twenty (20) days in advance, at the office of the Parks and Recreation Department. A deposit of ten dollars (\$10.00) per hour shall be charged, payable in advance, to cover any damage or special cost to the Town. Denial of a group permit may be appealed to the Town Council pursuant to Chapter 4 of Title 1 of the San Anselmo Municipal Code.

**DOGS IN TOWN PARKS
REGULATIONS & GUIDELINES**

Memorial Park

Memorial Park has the Town's largest children's play area and the busiest picnic and sports facilities in San Anselmo. In order to ensure the enjoyment and safe use of the Park by all users, dogs are allowed in this park under the following conditions:

- Dogs must be leashed in all areas of the park between 8:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m., all other rules still apply.
- Dogs are to be controlled by owners/keepers at all times so as to allow the safe use and enjoyment of others in the park.
- Dogs may not enter the fenced children's playground area.
- Dogs may not be on turf areas during organized or sports activities.

Robson-Harrington Park

Robson-Harrington Park is a neighborhood Park in a residential area. It is divided into an upper and lower recreation area. The Recreation Department uses the Park for a Day Camp during the Summer months and for other activities throughout the year. It is also used for an After School Program during the school year. To ensure the safety of the children and to reduce the Town's liability:

- Dogs must be on leash at all times in the area being used by organized children's programs. (Signs will be designed which can be posted to indicate when an area is under restricted use, for example, a portable sandwich board to be placed and removed by program supervisors)
- Dogs are to be controlled by owners at all times so as to allow the safe use and enjoyment of others in the park.
- Dogs may not interfere with informal recreation activities.

Creek Park

Creek Park is located in downtown San Anselmo adjacent to the shopping district. It is used by people of all ages for picnicking, socializing, and to enjoy a quiet restful environment. It is also used for public events such as Country Fair Days, The Antique Dealers Fair, and Movies in the Park. In order to insure the enjoyment and safe use of the park by users:

- Dogs must be leashed in all areas of the Park at all times.
- Dogs are to be controlled by owners at all times so as to allow the safe use and enjoyment of others in the part.

Town Hall

Town Hall is centrally located in downtown San Anselmo. Its grounds are considered a park area and are used for informal picnicking, socializing, and a quiet restful enjoyment. In order to insure its enjoyment and safe use:

- Dogs must be leashed in all areas at all times.
- Dogs are to be controlled by owners at all times so as to allow the safe use and enjoyment of others in the park.

Lansdale Station Park Playground

Lansdale Station Park is a fenced children's playground with adjacent parking lot:

- Dogs are not allowed in the fenced playground area.

Sorich Ranch Open Space Park

Sorich Ranch Park is a town owned open space park with land and trails adjacent to Marin County Open Space District lands. Its use is governed by a Master Plan adopted by the Town Council in August of 1994.. In accordance with the intent of the Sorich Ranch Park Master Plan and to insure the safety and enjoyment of Park users, animals, and wildlife:

- Dogs are allowed within the Park, provided, however, that the owner, keeper or person exercising the animal shall keep their animal under voice control at all times, to allow the safe use and enjoyment of others in the park. Voice Control is defined as being within sight and under voice command at all times.
- Owners may not allow their dogs to interfere or chase other animals or wildlife.
- Dogs are not allowed in restricted habitat areas that are posted.

Note: Marin County Open Space District regulations require dogs to be on leash on Marin County trails adjacent to Sorich Ranch Park.

Faude Park

Faude Park is a Town owned Open Space Preserve.

- Dogs are allowed within the Park, provided, however, that the owner, keeper or person exercising the animal shall keep their animal under voice control at all times, to allow the safe use and enjoyment of others in the park. Voice Control is defined as being within sight and under voice command at all times.
- Owners may not allow their dog to interfere or chase other animals or wildlife.
- Dogs are not allowed in restricted habitat areas that are posted.
