

RESOLUTION NO. 4106

**A RESOLUTION OF THE TOWN COUNCIL OF THE TOWN OF SAN ANSELMO
AUTHORIZING THE TOWN MANAGER OR THE PUBLIC WORKS DIRECTOR TO
EXECUTE THE AGREEMENT WITH THE STATE OF CALIFORNIA FOR THE
SADPW LOW IMPACT DEVELOPMENT DEMONSTRATION PROJECT**

WHEREAS, the Town of San Anselmo Department of Public Works endeavors to protect the water quality of local creeks by encouraging groundwater infiltration,

WHEREAS, the impervious surfaces in the watershed contribute to the severity of localized flooding problems,


WHEREAS, building techniques, such as bioretention and Low Impact Development, exist for the purpose of mimicking natural hydrology and encouraging groundwater infiltration,

WHEREAS, the Town of San Anselmo applied for, and was awarded, a grant for \$546,517 to the California Water Quality Control Board for design and construction of three bioretention systems on Town property,

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, that the Town Manager or the Public Works Director is authorized to execute the Agreement, No. 14-453-550, with the California Water Quality Control Board
