

RESOLUTION NO. 485

1 WHEREAS, the Town of San Anselmo owns all that certain real
2 property located in the Town of San Anselmo, County of Marin,
3 State of California, more particularly described as follows:-

4 Beginning at a point which is the most Easterly corner of
5 that certain tract conveyed by Kathrine H. Butler, et al, to
6 Ernest Ongaro and Anita P. Ongaro by deed recorded April 24, 1946
7 in volume 516 at page 275. Official records of Marin County;
8 said point also being a point in the Southwesterly boundary of
9 that certain tract conveyed by Northwestern Pacific Railroad
10 Company, a California Corporation to the Town of San Anselmo, a
11 Municipal Corporation, by deed recorded July 13, 1946 in Volume
12 520 at page 292, Official records of Marin County; and running
13 thence Southeasterly along the Southwesterly boundary of said
14 last mentioned deed a distance of 235 feet, more or less, to a
15 point on a line bearing South 69° 43' West; said last named line
16 being the Westerly extension of the Southerly boundary of that
17 certain tract conveyed by the Northwestern Pacific Railroad
18 Company, a California Corporation, to John J. Ongaro and Pearl
19 Ongaro, by deed recorded January 13, 1944 in Volume 460 at page
20 16, Official records of Marin County; thence running North 69°
21 43' East 24.5 feet to the most southerly corner of the afore-
22 mentioned parcel conveyed by the Northwestern Pacific Railroad
23 Company to John J. and Pearl Ongaro; thence running Northwesterly
24 in a straight line and parallel to the Southwesterly boundary of
25 the aforementioned parcel conveyed by the Northwestern Pacific
26 Railroad Company to the Town of San Anselmo; a distance of 247
27 feet; thence running North 4° 58' East 60 feet more or less to
28 Southerly line of that certain public street established by
29 Resolution No. 479 of the Town of San Anselmo on March 1950;
30 thence running North 85° 02' West along the said Southerly line of

1 running South 4°58' West 70 feet, more or less, to the Northeaster-
2 ly line of the aforementioned parcel conveyed by Kathrine H. Butler
3 et al to Ernest and Anita P. Ongaro; thence running along the
4 Northeasterly line of the last mentioned parcel of land South
5 48°32' East, 9 feet, more or less, to the point of beginning.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the City Council of the
7 Town of San Anselmo as follows:

8 1. That public convenience and necessity require the
9 establishing, opening and maintenance of a public street across
10 all of the property hereinabove described and the same is hereby
11 declared to be a public street in the Town of San Anselmo.

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13 The foregoing resolution was duly passed and adopted at a
14 regular adjourned meeting of the City Council of the Town of
15 San Anselmo on the 21st day of March, 1950, by the following vote,
16 to-wit:
